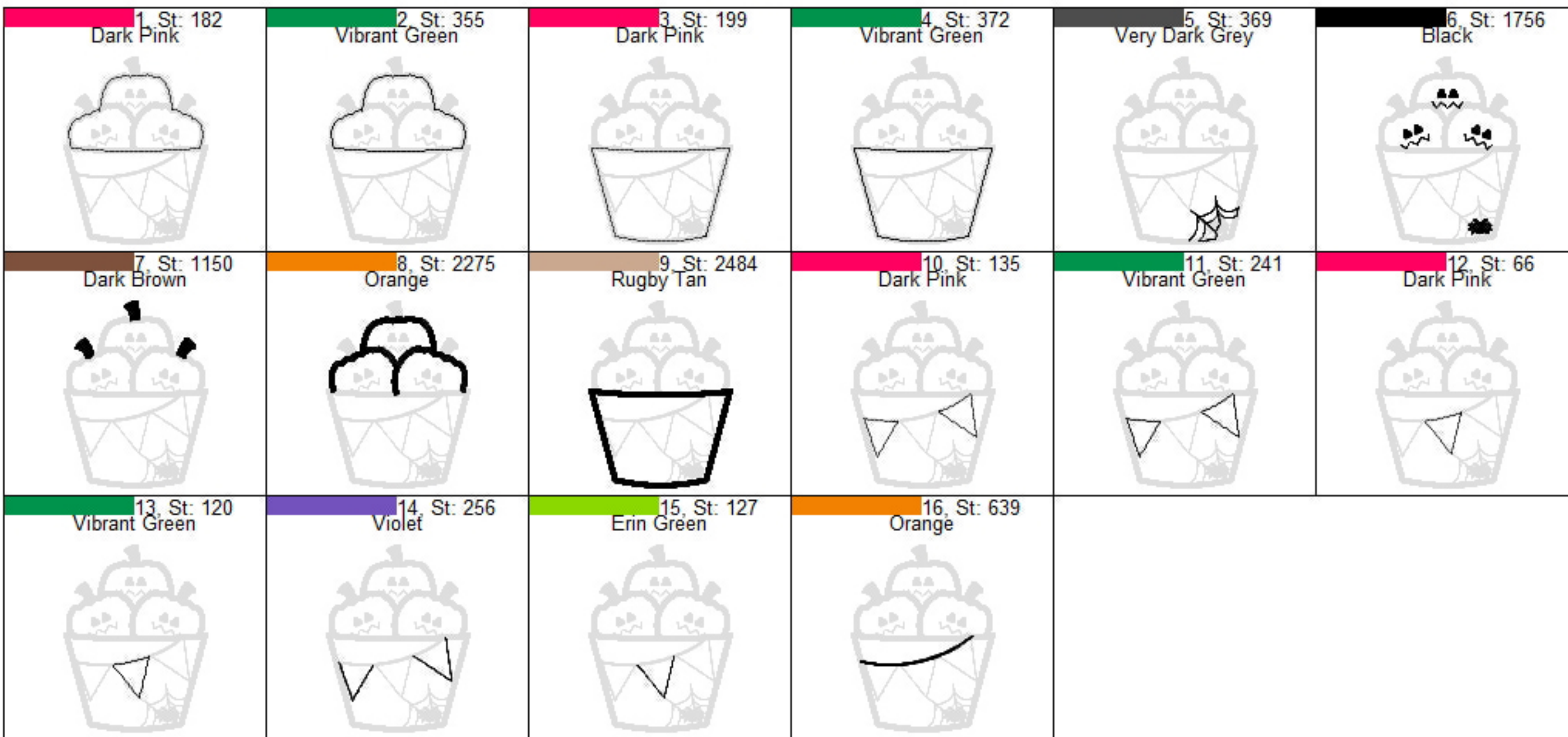




Steps 1-9 are for the applique barrel:

Steps 1 and 3 are fabric placement lines.

Steps 2 and 4 tack down the fabric. Trim fabric before moving on to the next step.

Steps 5-9 are satin stitches and details.

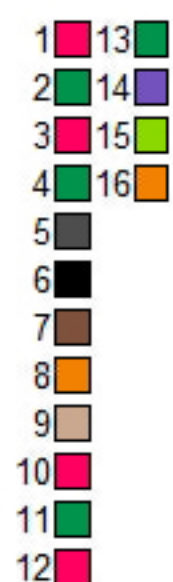
Steps 10-16 are for the raggy pennant:

Steps 10 and 12 are fabric placement lines. We recommend using a layer of flannel under under the fabric for raggy designs.

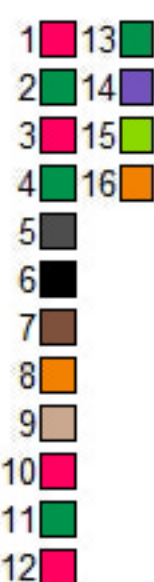
Steps 11 and 13 tack down the fabric. To achieve the look of our sample, trim close to edge on the top of the triangle, but leave more of an edge on the other two sides (the amount depends on the look you want.)

Steps 14-16 are triple bean stitches to finish the pennant.
