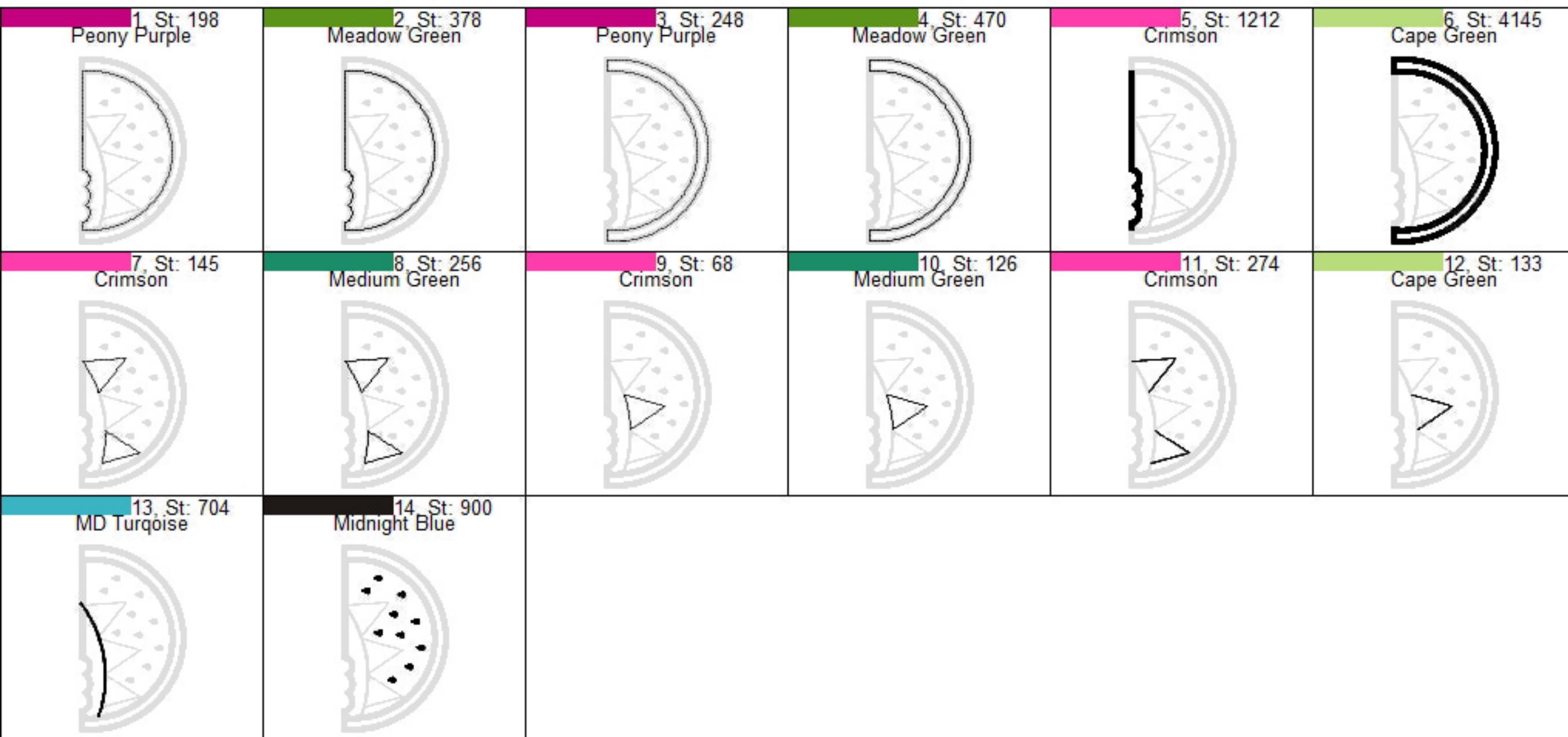




Steps 1-6 are for the applique watermelon:

Steps 1 and 3 are fabric placement lines.

Steps 2 and 4 tack down the fabric. Trim fabric before moving on to the next step.

Steps 5 and 6 are satin stitches and details.

Steps 7-13 are for the raggy pennant:

Steps 7 and 9 are fabric placement lines. We recommend using a layer of flannel under under the fabric for raggy designs.

Steps 8 and 10 tack down the fabric. To achieve the look of our sample, trim close to edge on the top of the triangle, but leave more of an edge on the other two sides (the amount depends on the look you want.)

Steps 12 and 13 are triple bean stitches to finish the pennant.

Step 14 is embroidered seeds.
